^(a) Full meter installations are charged on an actual time and materials basis. The District will collect the following deposits toward full set installation costs:

Major Road – Flagging Deposit:	\$1,000 (additional)
3" or larger meter	\$1,000 (additional)

^(b) Fieldwork and administrative support for projects is charged on an actual time and materials basis and may be higher than the required deposit. If the actual costs of time and materials are less than the deposit(s), the District will refund the balance to the applicant. If actual installation costs exceed the deposit, the District will bill the applicant and collect the additional amount due. Due to situations beyond the District’s control, such as delays in other agency inspections and permits, final installation billings may occur after an installation job has been completed. Delays in excess of six months can and do occur. For that reason, the District may elect to perform interim billings before final project acceptance. Applicants for service are advised to contact the District’s offices to determine if all charges for an installation project have been billed.

Note: Customers are required to install backflow prevention devices at their own expense consistent with District specifications.
